Asafotufiam festival, which is celebrated by the people of Big Ada and Ada Foah annually, to commemorate the victories of their warriors in battle and those who fell on the battlefield.

64 cyclists from the various regions of Ghana representing different teams participated in the race and they covered a distance of 78km. The race was won by Mr. Emmanuel Amoako of Team River Park in a time of 2:16:24sec. Samuel Anim of Team Young Stars came second in a time of 2:18:36sec., and Aminu Osman Mohammed of Team Pace Setters came third in a time of 2:18:52sec. The race was graced by Nene Debrah Paramount Chief of Ada traditional area.
